Bruiser Flint, Former Head Coach, Drexel University



Kris Holtzer, *Head Coach, Delaware Valley H.S.* A highly successful preps coach at Delaware Valley H.S. in



Milford, Pa., Holtzer also serves as the director of the Tri-State Revolution AAU program. A former assistant at Division II Lock Haven, where he was also an all-conference player and a 1,000-point scorer, Holtzer has also worked with several NBA players, including Carmelo Anthony, Kyrie Irving, Kelly Olynyk, and Evan Turner.

Kevin Driscoll, Assistant coach, NJIT

A graduate of Misericordia, Driscoll in June joined Brian



Kennedy's staff at NJIT after three highly successful years at Holy Cross, where he helped the Crusaders to two postseason appearances, including the 2016 NCAA Tournament, where they knocked off Southern University for HC's first NCAA win since 1953. Driscoll also previously worked as an assistant at Albright.

A four-time Colonial Athletic Conference Coach of the Year, Flint is the all-time winningest coach in Drexel basketball history. Flint's teams at Drexel went 245-217 in his 15 seasons in Philadelphia, making five appearances in the NCAA. The Dragons won 15 or more games 10 times under Flint, including a 29-win season in 212 when they won the CAA regular season title and advanced to the NIT quarterfinals.

Prior to Drexel, the 1987 graduate of St. Joseph's spent five seasons at UMass, taking the Minutemen to the post season in three of those, including a pair of NCAA appearances. Flint was the fastest coach in UMass history to reach 30 wins and was the winningest first-year coach ever at UMass. Flint served as an assistant at UMass under John Calipari for seven seasons before taking over the program. He began his coaching career as an assistant at Coppin State in 1987.

A 1987 Saint Joseph's graduate, Flint, 39, was a four-year letterwinner with the Hawks. He earned All-Atlantic 10 honors as a senior and led Saint Joseph's to the 1986 A-10 championship and a berth in the NCAA Tournament as a junior. The Hawks also made NIT appearances in 1984 and 1985. He was inducted into the Saint Joseph's Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998

Mike Deane, Assistant coach, James Madison

Deane has been a head coach for 30 of his 38-year coaching

career, including stops at Siena, Marquette, and Lamar — all three of which reached the NCAA Tournament under his direction. An assistant at James Madison since 2012, Deane's defensive expertise helped turn the Dukes into one of the top defensive teams in the CAA and helped them to an NCAA appearance in 2013.

Will Cabrera, Assistant coach, Lebanon Valley

Cabrera joins Brad McAlester's staff at LVC with seven years of



coaching experience that includes stints with his alma mater, Division III Messiah; Division II Mansfield; and with the Bolivian national team. Cabrera has also worked since 2009 as a coach and counselor for the Hoop Group's Elite Camps and has been a head coach with two different prep programs.
